

PDF Instructions

Beautiful Gallery Bandstand Card



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Materials:

- Basic Black Cardstock
 - Cut one base piece @ $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$."
 - Cut 2 pieces @ $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{5}{8}$."
 - Cut 2 strips @ $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ ", emboss them with a textured embossing folder, then cut each to $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", $1\frac{3}{4}$ ", and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.
 - Cut two more strips @ $4\frac{1}{8}$ " x $\frac{5}{8}$ " and emboss them with the same folder.
 - Die cut a tree for the front. I used one from (retired) Snowman Magic Dies.
- DSP scene from Beautiful Gallery, cut to 5" width x $4\frac{1}{8}$ " tall. Cut $\frac{3}{4}$ " off each side and keep the pieces together to maintain the picture.
- Basic Beige Cardstock
 - 4" x 2" for "wishing"
 - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{4}$ " for "you were here"
 - $3\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3" for the back (you can go as large as 4" x $3\frac{3}{8}$ "
- Window Sheet, 4" x 2"

Directions:

- Score the base piece @ $\frac{7}{8}$ " and $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Fold sides in toward the middle and burnish with a bone folder.
- Glue the DSP onto the Black base, $\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces on each end and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " piece in the center.
- Score the two $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $\frac{5}{8}$ " strips @ $\frac{1}{2}$ ", $2\frac{1}{4}$ ", $4\frac{1}{4}$ ", and 6". Fold (mountain folds) and burnish.
- Flatten out the base and attach these strips to the top and bottom by wrapping the $\frac{1}{2}$ " ends around and gluing them to the back. Make sure they are all the way to the top and the bottom of the base. Do NOT glue any part of the strip except the 2 end tabs.
- Adhere the Window Sheet to the center with Glue Dots with the top and bottom behind the black strips.
- Emboss the $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips with an embossing folder. I used (retired) Timber 3D Embossing Folder. Next cut each strip into 3 pieces, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", $1\frac{3}{4}$ ", and $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".

- Glue these to the top and bottom strips that are on top and bottom of the base.
- Stamp “wishing” from Delightful Wishes Stamp Set and die cut with the matching die. Attach it to the top of the Window Sheet with Glue Dots.
- Die cut a tree and adhere it to the Window Sheet with Glue Dots.
- Glue sentiment strip at the bottom.



- On the back, stamp trees from (retired) Lovely As a Tree Stamp Set and “Miss You” from Simply Said ~ all with black ink. Glue the stamped Basic Beige piece to the middle back of base.
- Glue the embossed 4-1/8”x 5/8” strips to both side sections on the back. This will cover the seams created by the horizontal strips.

This will lay flat to fit into a medium envelope. To display, pull the side sections forward and stand it up. More pictures are on the next pages.
